Section III

A. The Scholarship Program requires applicants to submit a 500-word personal essay. The essay should give some insight into your personality, goals, skills, and achievements.

B. Two letters of recommendation are required. Letters may not be written by a family member and should have been written within the past year.

Eligibility Requirements

Only eligible students may qualify for scholarships under the Living for Purpose Community Development Center Scholarship Program. The Program is an affirmative action, equal opportunity organization and does not discriminate in the selection process for a scholarship winner on the basis of race, creed, color, sex, handicap, sexual orientation, national origin, or any other class of peoples protected by the United States Constitution, State and Federal Laws.

In order to be eligible to be considered as a scholarship recipient under the Program you must comply with the following requirements:

- Applicants must complete the application in its entirety and submit it within the required deadline.
- Applicant must have a high school diploma or an equivalent GED (or have attained one by the deadline for submitting the application) and have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.
- Applicants must demonstrate financial need (determined as income of less than \$70,000/yr for a family of four).
- Applicant must demonstrate that he/she has been accepted at a university, college or vocational training center for the upcoming Fall semester.
- Applicant must use the Scholarship money for tuition only, in college, university or post secondary educational program which he or she attends within twelve months following the award of the scholarship money.
- All applicants must be U.S. citizens.

Recipients are awarded scholarships in the amount of \$500 which will be used to help pay for tuition for a college education.

Recipients are chosen based upon a combination of the following factors:

- Eligibility criteria
- Success in education
- The quality of the essay, including grammar, content, and ingenuity.

Disclosure

The identities of the members of the Scholarship Review Committee are kept strictly confidential. The Scholarship Review Committee reviews each application.

Scholarship Review Committee, Board Members, Employees and relatives of employees of Living for Purpose Community Development Center are not eligible to apply. Employees and family members of the colleges, universities, advertisers and their affiliates are not eligible to apply.
